

Garden Plot Rules and Guidelines

Background

- **Purpose is to maintain a pleasant, workable atmosphere in RA garden plots**
- **Rules have been refined over the years by RA**
- **Each plot renter signed and received the rules at the time of signing the plot rental agreement**
- **RA can cancel plot rental agreement for rule violations**
- **Abbreviated set of the rules will be posted at each garden plot.**
- **Legal committee will hear any disputes**

Rules and Guidelines

1-3) * All plots must be worked (cleared to the ground of weeds and soil turned) by May 1st and weed control continued into the fall. If not then RA can cancel the garden plot agreement.

4-6) Place materials in their proper place

- Organic material can only be placed in the compost bins not the trashcan.

- Trash material can only be placed in the trashcans not the compost bins.

- Only material from your plot gardening activities can be put into the compost bins and trashcan.

Rules and Guidelines

7, 11, 13) Plot Boundaries for mowers and safety

- All items for your gardening activities must be keep within the boundaries of your garden plot.**
- * Paths are not to be used for storage, fence supports, etc. or placing of wood chips, lumber,etc.**

9) Inhumane treatment of wildlife (even if they are eating your prize tomatoes) is unacceptable and VIOLATORS WILL BE PROSECUTED

10) * Do not take tools or vegetables from other gardeners without their permission. Theft of any kind will be prosecuted

Rules and Guidelines

8,12, 14-16 In your plot

- * No pesticides or chemical fertilizers are allowed in any of the garden plots (except Lake Anne)**
- All plants must be contained within your plot boundaries**
- No structures over 5 ft tall are permitted**
- Pressure-treated wood is not permitted anywhere in the garden area**
- Only legal plants species can be grown**
- Keep children and pets within your plot area**

17 Only appropriate attire is allowed in the garden area.
